It was a busy and successful season for both of our companies*

For Environova, the Antigonish area was once again our major focus. The Phase 2 Report for the Master Tree Plan and Strategy for the campus was completed along with Phase One of the The Green Area Assessment Report. Work also included the implementation and project management of the Nicholson Hall Parking Lot Landscape upgrade project carried over from our 2006 design work.

Two other projects include commissions for park design and landscape renovations for Chisholm and Cairn parks for the Town of Antigonish. Environova also carried out a Sports Field study which included an assessment of 22 recreation sites for the Town and County of Antigonish. The study was nearing completion by the end of the year and the final report due in early January of 2008.

On the south shore, the firm completed a landscape design and was also involved with the project management for the Narrows Basin Development in the Mahone Bay area.

Valley projects included the completion of the Hantsport Memorial Fountain project in Hantsport, a design for the Kingstech Day Care Centre in Kentville, and design work for the Jim Sweet Property in Aldersville, Kings Co. In the Halifax metro area we carried out design work for the Kelly St. Neighbourhood Park (Killiam Properties), A Buffer Zone Management Plan for Clayton Developments at Russell Lake West Phase 3, project Management for the site development work at the International Painters Union in Burnside Industrial Park, and a residential design for Kayleen Bell & Tracey Landscaping.

Some major tree and shrub plantings were installed this fall and the project should be completed by the summer of 2008.

At Pictou, over 140 large trees were planted around the estate grounds and the Par three Golf course. Some work still remains and will be carried over in 2008.
