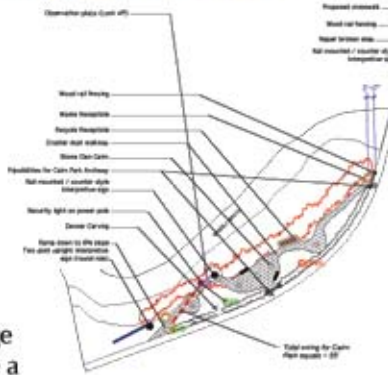
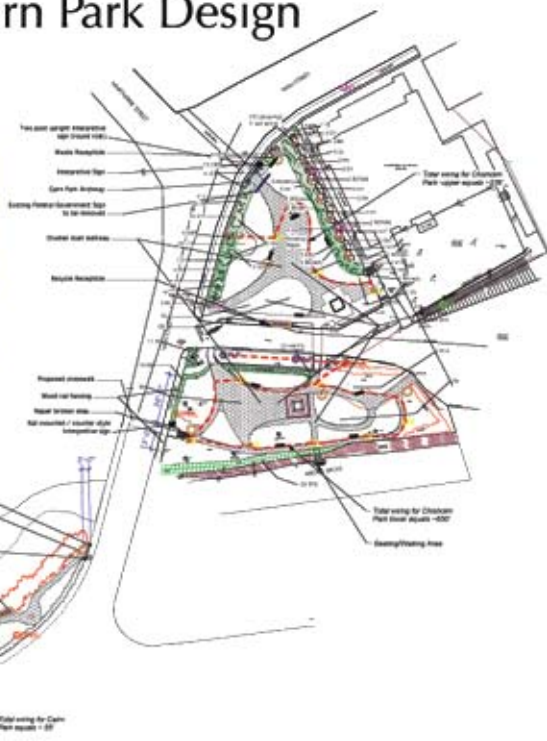


Chisholm Park and Cairn Park Design

Chisholm and Cairn Park mark the entrance to the downtown of Antigonish. Through the vegetative based design and prominent signage the parks provide a stunning welcome to the downtown area. The vegetative buffer also creates a sanctuary from the cacophony of a busy downtown intersection. Both parks have an important historical significance and are located on one of the major waterways in Antigonish. Environova's design incorporates both important aspects through the design of a look off, interpretive signage and pathway design.
